



Forming in 1999, The Joseph Filipow Trio began as a general business institution. Taking part in the Tanqueray Tuesday jazz series at The Jazz Kitchen in Indianapolis, Indiana, provided the organization with a wealth of exposure. Following this and other opportunities, the band continued to develop professionally, including festivals, night clubs, restaurants and even Indianapolis Dine Magazine.

Taking on residency in 2006 with Carnival Cruise Lines, the trio took stage 6 nights a week. In association with Columbus, Ohio's recording and performing artist, The Governor, and Jamaican bass virtuoso Peter Brown, the band embarked on a new level of music. Making the transition between general business and performance has allowed the outfit to develop exciting original music suited to almost any taste. The organization has since solidified following the departure of The Governor and now includes Andrew Kirk, a talented young drummer from the streets of Pittsburgh.

One of Jamaica's finest exports, Peter Brown has a reputation that echoes through out the Caribbean. His extensive resume boasts performances at Reggae Sunsplash, Jamaica's largest festival, and Air Jamaica jazz fest with legendary Island recording artist Ernest Ranglin. In addition to performing at nearly every resort in Jamaica, Brown has shared the stage with The Drifters, Quako Bandele, and Calypso Rose to name a few. With the gospel and reggae from Jamaica, latin of Cuba, and bebop from America, his unique 7 string bass virtuosity reflects the diversity of his experience.



Originally from the steel city of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, Andrew Kirk has attained a level of proficiency on the drums reserved for veterans. After meeting his teacher and mentor at the Mellon Jazz Festival, Roger Humphries (Song for my Father, Cape Verdean Blues), Kirk continued to develop under the guard of the Pittsburgh jazz scene. Upon attending James Madison University, a relationship was forged with saxophone innovator and professor David Pope and ensemble director Chuck Dotas, providing Kirk with professional and practical experience. Other credits include various ensembles ranging from bluegrass, calypso, hip-hop and rock.



Headlining the Tanqueray Tuesday jazz series at The Jazz Kitchen in Indianapolis, Indiana, Joseph Filipow founded The Trio in 1999. Indianapolis provided a wealth of musicians for the young man to study and perform with, including Frank Glover, Jimmy Coe, Pookie Johnson, Jozelle Carter, Steven Weakley, Melvin Rhyne, Mad Harold Cardwell and Rob Dixon. In 2000, Filipow attended Indiana University to continue development under the supervision of David Baker, Luke Gillespie and Pat Harbison. In addition to numerous general business affairs, he appeared at Gumbo Aid, a benefit for hurricane Katrina, and WICR fest as well as on the OWL Studios Triology release What Things Could Be. Not limited to the guitar, Joseph is a composer, producer, lecturer, and engineer.
